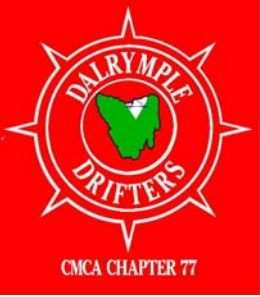

## March Rally Mrytle Park



### A couple of mobile phone tips from Danny Kelly.

1: Imagine your mobile phone battery is very low. To activate, reserve battery power, press the keys \*3370#. Your mobile phone will restart with this reserve and battery power should show approx 50% increase in battery. This reserve will get charged when you charge your mobile phone next time, but will give you sufficient power to ring out.

2: Checking your mobile phone's serial number, key in the following digits, star-hash-zero-six-hash \*#06#.

A 15 digit code will appear on the screen. This number is unique to your handset. Write it down and keep it somewhere safe. If and when your phone is stolen, you can phone your service provider and give them the code. They will then be able to block your handset so if the thief changes the SIM card, your phone will be totally useless. You probably won't get your phone back, but at least you know that whoever stole it can't use/sell it either. If everyone done this, there would be no point in people stealing mobile phones.
